Brother William Robert Cooper, known to us all as 'Bill' was initiated into Carnation Applecross Chapter No. 84 on 9th May 1990 and was a Member until 13th November 2019 when the Chapter became dormant.

On 5th October 2012 Brother Cooper affiliated into Perth Chapter No. 46 and remained a Member until his passing to a Higher Chapter on 4th April 2020.

He is remembered as being the 'life and soul of the party' and always willing to take part in Committee discussions for the good of the Order. We all admired how he coped with his health problems over the past 14 years and especially during his term as Most Worthy Grand Patron.

He served the Order of the Eastern Star very well and will be sadly missed and fondly remembered.
