In making this report, you will be requested to provide your name and contact details but you have the right to confidentiality and your details will not be disclosed to the member or Chapter you are making the claim against (the 'Complainee') unless you provide consent. The Complainee also has a right to confidentiality and if any details of this report or the results of any investigation or action(s) taken, have been found to be disclosed to anyone else, you or any of the parties involved in this report could be held accountable for a breach of confidentiality and also disciplined under this process.
